The goal of our admissions policy is to identify students whose lives will be enriched through participation in the spiritual and educational programs offered at WCCA. In assessing a prospective student, the school will consider the following factors in determining the suitability of programs that will match each student.

Criteria for Spiritual Commitment:

1. The parent(s) and the student are required to read and understand the "Declaration of Faith."
2. The student and at least one parent must profess Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.
3. The student must participate in and be open to spiritual growth.
4. The parent(s) and the student must be active and faithful in church attendance.

Criteria for Academic Performance:

1. All students will be academically assessed upon admission. Additionally, there will be ongoing assessment throughout the year to determine each student's academic progress.
2. Students with special academic needs will be evaluated on an individual basis to determine if our program will be suitable to meet their needs.

Criteria for Behavioral Performance:

1. Students will be required to adhere to the rules of the school as stated in the Policies and Procedures Handbook.
2. Parents will be required to cooperate and enforce the disciplinary rules as stated in the Policies and Procedures Handbook.
